Seminars, Conferences, Workshops 2023-2024

In the session 2023-24, the Government General Degree College, Singur, observed a plethora of various seminars and workshops to foster holistic growth of the students. Like every earlier year the IQAC of this college in collaboration with different departments of this college organized several seminars in the College. The topics of those seminars covered a wide array of disciplines such as Psychological counselling, Environmental Sustainability, Anthropological discourses, Health and Wellbeing, Economics as well as Career guidance of the students. Many of them covered the important points of Research Methodologies in different disciplines, also.

On 10th October, 2023, World Mental Health Day, Awareness Programme on “Nurturing Young Minds: Promoting Mental Health Awareness” was organized by the Department of Psychology, to generate awareness on mental health. The speakers for the programme were renowned film maker, Mr. Sourav Sarkar and Counsellor, Prof. Shaona Sengupta, who discussed different aspects of mental health to generate awareness among the students. The programme was attended by 59 participants.

On 4th January, 2024, Members from Indian Autism Centre delivered lecture and interacted with the students on the ways of getting success even with inherent disabilities. Speaker for the programme was Mr. Sumit Agarwal, icon of the Election Commission of India, SDG Ambassador for Diversity and Inclusion, and Mentor of Change for Niti Ayog. The programme was attended by 72 participants.

On 20th February, 2024, Dr. Sashinath Mandal, Associate Professor of Law, Hooghly Government Law College and Dr. Arpita Ghosh, Law officer (WBLs) Chinsurah delivered a lecture on Intellectual Property Rights and Remedies in India, in a one day seminar organized by IQAC, GGDC Singur. The programme was attended by 76 participants.

On 13th March, 2024, a seminar on “Mental Well-being in Digital Age” was organized by the Department of Computer Science and IQAC. The speaker for the programme was Prof. Shaona Sengupta, Assistant Professor, Department of Psychology, Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Govt. College, Kolkata. The programme focused on the emerging mental health issues in digital age and the ways of mitigation. The seminar was attended by 62 participants.

A total of 68 participants enrolled for the seminar. Following are the details:

Day 1: Session 1

Speaker: Prof. Subir Biswas, West Bengal State University.

Topic: Ethical Issues in Anthropological Fieldwork

Addressing the ethical challenges inherent in Research, Prof. Biswas highlighted the need to understand and respect cultural values and norms. In the realm of social anthropology, Prof. Biswas assured that there should be no physical harm to participants, emphasizing the importance of protecting participants privacy. He also discussed the autonomy of ethics, advocating that benefits should be directed towards participants.

Day 1: Session 2

Speaker: Dr. Sankha Priya Guha, Associate Professor. Bidhannagar Government College.

Topic: Doing Fieldwork in Social- Cultural Anthropology: The Context Producing the Text

Professor Guha's comprehensive discourse on anthropological as well as ethnographic methods provided attendees with a profound understanding of the significance of field work in Anthropology and the ethical imperatives that guide research practices in this field. He also emphasized the data collection entails gathering information in a manner that respects participants privacy and confidentiality, ensuring data accuracy and integrity. Lastly, avoiding ethnocentrism involves recognizing and avoiding the tendency to judge other cultures based on the standards and values of one's own culture.

Day 2: Session 3

Topic: Importance of field Geology in Archaeological Anthropology

Speaker: Dr. Debasis Kumar Mondol. University of Calcutta

Dr. Mondol, discussed the topic of field geology which was very needed Topic for Anthropological faculties. He stressed upon the old school as well as new school methods that were helpful in Archaeological studies. The fieldwork which has changed over the course of time and their effectiveness towards the study of Archaeological studies was very much needed.

Day 2: Session 4

Topic: Fieldwork in Anthropology: Some Thoughts and Experiences Speaker:

Former Professor. Barun Mukhopadhyay. Indian Statistical Institute.

Professor Mukhopadhyay, delivered an enlightening speech on the thoughts and experience of fieldwork in Anthropology. He emphasized that fieldwork allow researchers to directly engage with diverse biology, gaining invaluable insights essential for Anthropological study. Professor Mukhopadhyay 's comprehensive discourse provided attendees with a profound understanding of the significance of fieldwork in Anthropology and the biological imperatives that guide research practices in the field.

On 22nd March, 2024, the Internal Complaints Committee & IQAC, GGDC Singur organized a One-day Seminar on “Combating Invasive Breast Cancer - a potential challenge for cancer biologists”. The speaker was Dr. Suwendu Chakraborty of MUC Women's College, Burdwan. Dr. Chakraborty discussed different aspects of feminine cancer to a huge gathering of girl students and teachers.
